## Teacher Spotlight

### Deedra Leavitt

Ms. Leavitt graduated from the University of Maine at Machias with a BS in Junior High Education. Following graduation she moved to East Millinocket where she taught 8th grade reading and social studies at Schenck High School. While she was there she also coached the cheering squad and began to work on her Master's Degree in Middle Level Education. Two years later she was hired by the Glenburn School Department to teach 7th grade reading, writing, social studies, science and "art on a cart".

During her years at Glenburn she has had a variety of teaching responsibilities. She also coached cheering and then girl's basketball. 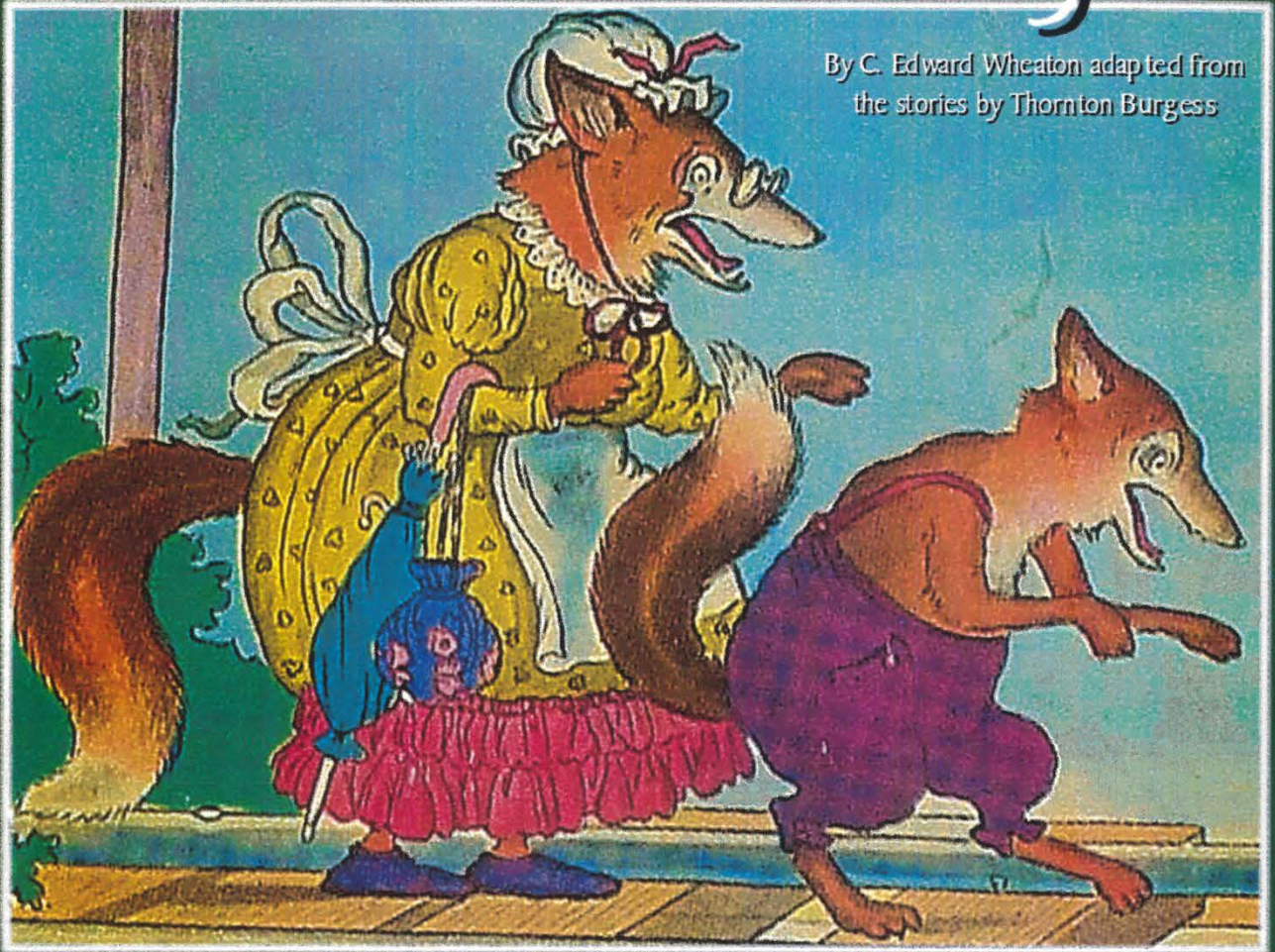

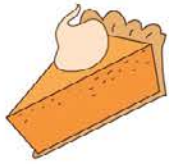

STEP 2: Enter information as requested. You must enter a valid email address.

- Once you complete the registration process, you will see in red that an email has been sent to you. In the email, there will be a link that says "Click here to select conference time" which will take you to the page where you can select your conference times
- Select an available time for each teacher by clicking in the box next to the open time slot and click "Confirm Selection"
- You will receive an email confirming the conference time you scheduled with each of the teachers.
- If you need to schedule conferences for another child, follow the instructions above.
